# LITHUANIAN ANNUAL STRATEGIC REVIEW

#### Aims and scope

Lithuanian Annual Strategic Review (LASR) is a peer-reviewed scientific journal publishing highquality, original research. LASR is indexed in SCOPUS and classified as a Q4 journal in the Scimago Journal Rank.

The journal focuses on *international security and defence* issues which directly or indirectly affect the *Baltic and Black Sea region* (analysing them from various perspectives of the social sciences).

*Lithuanian Annual Strategic Review* welcomes three types of articles:

- \* Research Articles (6000-8000 words),
- \* Policy Commentaries (2000 words),
- \* Book Reviews (1500 words).

LASR is published in electronic form twice per year by General Jonas Zemaitis Military Academy of Lithuania:

- \* In March (articles are collected until 1 October )
- \* In October (articles are collected until 1 May)

LASR reaches out to the academic community and political practitioners and offers ample opportunities for scholarly visibility and potential impact.

Please convert the files to PDF beforehand.

Authors are requested to submit a fully anonymised manuscript (one file) that contains:

- \* the article title,
- \* an abstract of 200 words,
- \* up to six keywords
- \* the article word count (including references)
- \* the article text
- \* list of references

#### **Peer Review**

Once your manuscript has been assessed for suitability by the editor, it will then be double-blind peerreviewed by independent, anonymous reviewers.

## **INSTRUCTIONS FOR AUTHORS**

#### Word Limits

A typical research article for this journal should be between 6000 and 8000 words, inclusive of tables and references.

Policy commentaries should not exceed 2,000 words and book reviews 1,500 words.

## Style Guidelines

Please use British English consistently throughout your manuscript.

#### Structure

Your manuscript should be compiled in the following order: title page; abstract (200 words); 3-6 keywords; main text introduction, materials and methods, results; acknowledgements; declaration of interest statement; references; appendices (as appropriate).

The introduction should contain a description of the problem, basic concepts, and frame of issues, provide the goal of the research and focus on reviewing the literature on the issue. Subsequent chapters should further elaborate on what is the thrust of the undertaken research to prove (or disapprove) the basic premise. The paper should close with conclusions, which should tie together the views presented in the previous sections of the work.

## Formatting

Contributors are asked to provide a single-spaced version of their manuscript as one file e-mail attachment in Microsoft Word format. A margin on all sides of 2,5 cm should be applied for the entire document.

Title - Arial 20. Abstract text: Times New Roman 10. Chapters and paragraphs: 1. level – Arial 16. 1.1. level – Arial 12 Bold. 1.1.1. level – Arial 12. Body Text: Times New Roman 12, Single space.

Tables: Title above the table. Table 1. Times New Roman 10 Bold. Figures: Title beneath the figure. Figure 1. Times New Roman 10 Bold.

The authors are requested to follow the APA (American Psychological Association) referencing style in the manuscripts. For more details, please check: <u>https://apastyle.apa.org/style-grammar-guidelines/references/examples</u>

A list of references should be provided at the end of the manuscript, generally arranged in alphabetical order and titled "LIST OF REFERENCES".

Any attempt of plagiarism will be followed by the rejection of the submitted manuscript. Authors should not submit the same work or describe essentially the same research in more than one journal. Submitting the same manuscript to more than one journal concurrently constitutes unethical publishing behaviour unless otherwise specified.
